

## Errata

In the paper “Association of Hematological Parameters with Insulin Resistance and  $\beta$ -Cell Dysfunction in Non-diabetic Subjects,” by Anthony Hanley, Ravi Retnakaran, Ying Qi, Hertzel Gerstein, Bruce Perkins, Janet Raboud, Stewart Harris, and Bernard Zinman (*J Clin Endocrinol Metab* 94:3824–3832, 2009), the authors report an error in the description of the study subjects. It is stated in the *Subjects and Methods*, in the middle of the 2nd paragraph (page 3825), that all subjects were confirmed to have a nondiabetic OGTT. While we confirm that none of the subjects were known to have diabetes at the time of the assessments, a small proportion (8%) had an OGTT abnormality of early diabetes, with the vast majority (88%) of these latter subjects classified based on a 2-h value of greater than 11.0 mmol/liter. This modification does not change the overall conclusions of the study. *The authors apologize for their error and any confusion this may have caused the readers.*
